

Statement on Provision of Remote Education

If there is a requirement to move your child to remote education, the class staff will discuss how this can work best for each individual child.

Opportunities that may be offered could include: -

- Delivery of physiotherapy equipment, resources, and programmes to home
- The loan of appropriate technology including switches and I pads via Aladdin's Cave
- Play and learning resources delivered home via Aladdin's Cave
- A weekly offer of remote face to face activities via an appropriate digital platform. This could include individual, paired or whole group sessions
- Regular phone and email contact to discuss the learning plan for your child and other holistic needs
- A plan of activities and resources that can be used to support your child at home at times that work for you
- Pre-recorded activities that you can use at times that work for you
- Signpost to other interesting activities that your child may enjoy, these will also be shared on a closed school social media page.
- A link to health and social care teams to make sure that actions and decisions are shared and supported
- Access to therapy sessions which can be led successfully remotely
- The opportunity to share home learning pictures and videos via Earwig
- Access to remote whole school celebrations

We will aim to plan to meet your child's individual learning adventure in the same way that we would if they were at school. We recognise that all of the children adapt to learning differently at home and there will be no one prescribed way that we expect this to happen. We will work with each family individually to work out what is best for them. There will be no expectation for children to complete a fixed amount of home learning.

We aim to continue to offer some form of remote learning if pupils are having to self-isolate once school is fully re-open and also if pupils have future long term medical absences but are able to engage with periods of learning as part of their recovery.
